Expand the Vision of Mountain Forests: From Taiwan to International Peaks

To promote mountain guiding and expand knowledge of mountain forests, the Sports Administration (SA) partnered with the National Taiwan Sport University to host the "2023 International Forum of Mountain Guide System" on November 5, 2023. The event featured a keynote speech by Steve Long, Chairman of the International Climbing and Mountaineering Federation (UIAA) Training Committee, as well as discussions led by Taiwan's mountain fauna conservationist, Kuo Yen-

jen, and renowned climber, Yang Chu-hao, who shared insights on both domestic and international mountain climbing environments and experiences. The Taiwan Wilderness Medical Association and Taiwan Mountain Magazine also participated, showcasing a Portable Altitude Chamber (PAC) and sharing information about Taiwan's mountain forests. The forum attracted nearly 100 enthusiastic mountaineers.

The West District Civic Sports Center in Chiayi City held a groundbreaking ceremony on November 11. Administrative Deputy Minister of Education Lin Tengchiao and Chiayi City Mayor Huang Min-hui jointly prayed for the safety and smooth construction. It is expected to be completed in September 2025, providing a friendly

environment, high-quality and safe sports venues for the local people.

The Center has planned a number of complete sports facilities, including an indoor heated swimming pool, a new type gym, an all-age physical training ground, a yoga classroom, a rhythm classroom, a multi-function classroom, a multi-purpose court and other facilities to meet different sports needs. These facilities aim to foster a sports-for-all environment in Chiayi and contribute to the development of a healthy and joyful city.

New University Baseball League season set to start Open level 1 games to kick off in Taitung on December 22

The 2023 University Baseball League is about to start a new season. The opening press conference was held on November 13. Fang Jui-wen, Deputy Director-General of the SA, hopes to collaborate closely with the Chinese Taipei University Sports Federation to enhance college baseball and develop top talents. The most watched Level 1 open matches will start in Taitung on November 22nd

culminating in the champion being determined on January 17th and 18th, 2024, after preliminary and semi-final tests.

The college stage is a period for students to grow and develop character, and it's equally essential for players to refine their skills and mental resilience. Our aim is to motivate all baseball-loving students to challenge their boundaries. "I am here"

embodies confidence, unity, and support for teammates, serving as the guiding spirit of the new season. We appreciate every role, with each player contributing to the team and the UBL. Together, we craft exciting events. UBL eagerly anticipates embarking on this thrilling journey with players and fans alike.

Deputy Director Fang underscored the significance of fostering sports talents as a pillar of national strength and a key component of Taiwan's global competitiveness. The UBL has actively contributed to boosting Taiwan's baseball competitiveness, leading to enhancements in team quality, increased participation, and a notable expansion of baseball facilities. To continue promoting comprehensive baseball-related initiatives and upholding Taiwan's baseball legacy, future efforts will prioritize quality and collaboration with schools, county governments, and non-governmental organizations, guided by the principle of "equal emphasis on quality" to set down the roots of student baseball.

In recent years, Taiwan's national baseball team has excelled internationally. The SA prioritizes nurturing the next generation, and the UBL is renowned as the "Cradle of Taiwanese Pro Players." Among the players who participated in the competition last year, 19 people, including Lin Hua-wei (National Taiwan University of



Sport), Chen Sheng-wen (National Chiayi University), Lin Wang-shi (Chinese Culture University), and Hsin Jun-sheng (National Taiwan Sport University), were recruited by the Chinese Professional Baseball League. The press conference also included last year's champion teams: National Taiwan University of Sport, National University of Kaohsiung, University of Taipei, and Soochow University. They shared their championship experiences and emphasized teamwork and self-improvement, encouraging all athletes to prepare and shine on the right stage.

This academic year, 123 teams from 97 schools will compete in various categories: open level one, open level two, general group, and open girls' group. The open level 1 competition starts on November 22, with 16 teams in the preliminaries playing in Taitung and Kaohsiung. The semi-finals will be at the National Taiwan

University of Sport Baseball Stadium in Taichung, featuring the top 8 teams in a single round-robin competition, with the

finals broadcast live on MOMO TV and SSU TV.

■ UBL 大專棒球聯賽迎接新賽季 公開一級 22 日臺東開打

112 學年度 UBL 大專棒球聯賽即將點燃 戰火,今(13) 日舉行開賽記者會,教育部體育 署房瑞文副署長期許持續與大專體總共同努力 下,積極爲大專棒球選手打造優質的舞臺,培 育更多優秀的棒球人才,並提升大專棒球能見 度。最受矚目的公開一級賽事將在本(11) 月 22 日於臺東開打,經過預、複賽階段的考驗, 明(113)年1月17、18日迎接冠軍產生。

大學階段不僅是學生跨域學習,人格成熟的養成時期,也是選手磨練技術、強化心智的重要階段,希望鼓勵所有熱愛棒球的學子能多方探索、挑戰自我,本學年度以「有我在」作爲新賽季的精神引領,旣是充滿信心的自我喊話,也是對隊友夥伴、對支持對象最堅定的信任和鼓勵,希望肯定每個角色的價值,都是成就團隊和大專聯賽的一份子,成爲彼此的力量,共同創造更精彩的賽事,UBL 也期待陪伴所有選手、球迷盡情享受和挑戰。

體育署房瑞文副署長表示,培育運動人才 乃是奠立國力的根基,亦是國家全球競爭力的 一環,藉由大專棒球聯賽的辦理,積極提升我 國棒球競技實力,不論是在球隊質的提升、量 的增加甚或是簡易球場數量,都已有明顯增長。 爲賡續推動成效,使推動棒球相關事務更臻完 善,延續我國棒球運動的榮光,未來更將以「質 量並重」 為原則,持續與學校、各縣市政府及 民間團體合作,扎根深耕學生棒球運動。

近年來我國棒球代表隊在國際舞臺上屢創佳績,體育署也相當著重於培育新生代球員,UBL大專棒球聯賽一直以來都有「中華職棒選手搖籃」稱號,上學年度曾參與賽事的選手中,包括林華偉(臺體大)、陳聖文(嘉大)、林旺熙(文大)、辛俊昇(國體)等19人獲得中華職棒球團靑睞,記者會也邀請上學年度各組冠軍球隊臺灣體大、高雄大學、臺北市大學、東吳大學代表一同分享奪冠當下心情,並分享甘苦談,訓練期間透過團隊合作方式持續提升自我,也替自己未來厚植競爭力,不論在什麼領域,勉勵所有參賽運動員,只要準備好自己,都能在適合的舞臺發光發熱。

本學年度賽事共有 97 校合計 123 隊參與, 分爲公開一級、公開二級、一般組以及公開女 生組。公開一級賽事將在 11 月 22 日開戰,預 賽 16 隊進行單循環賽事,先後在臺東、高雄 開打;複賽於臺中臺體大棒球場進行,由 8 強 球隊採單循環賽,且複、決賽提供場場直播, 邀請大家一同關注 UBL 大專棒球聯賽,並鎖定 MOMO TV、SSU TV 帶來的轉播服務,爲選手 加油。

Lien Chen-ling, a member of Japan's Komatsu judo club, previously captained the club and won gold for Taiwan at the Hangzhou Asian Games. The Komatsu judo team is the top women's judo team in Japan and has recently established a new Shoushikan dojo, attracting many foreign teams for training.
